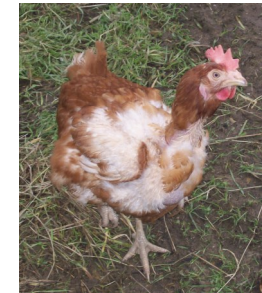
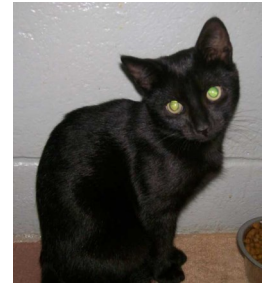
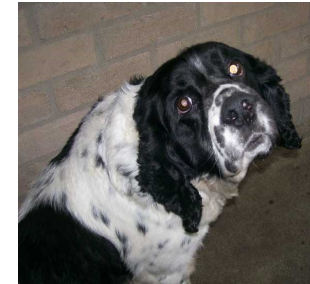

Leave a Legacy of Care to Animal Care

Animal Care was formed in 1978 by a small number of dedicated people who looked after stray dogs and cats in their own homes. Over a period of time, kennels were rented and the number of animals increased.

In 1987, Blea Tarn Kennels were acquired and then refurbished to accommodate 25 dogs, 30 cats/kittens and a large variety of other animals. The Kennels were officially opened on the 19th March 1988.

Every year we find homes for over 800 dogs, cats and other animals, some of their stories are on the back of this leaflet.
